Competition Format – 54 holes individual stroke events. 36 hole team event. Field is limited to 180 players.

Each country is entitled to enter, in AB division, one boys' team and one girls' team, each team has the max of 4 players, with top 3 scores from each round recorded for team total.

Each country is entitled to enter, in CD division, one mix team, max of 4 players, with top 3 scores from each round recorded for team total.

Qualifier events for local players – Qualifier Leg 1: June 13th; Leg 2: June 14th; Monday National Qualifier: August 3th

International Junior Masters exemptions – Winner of both boy and girl of the A division will earn an exemption to compete in the 2027 International Junior Masters Golf Invitation, entry fee free, at East Aurora Country Club, NY, USA.

Future Champion Golf AR Junior World Cup Invitation exemptions – Winner of both boy and girl from A and B division, will earn their spot in 2027 FCG AR Junior World Cup, Kingsmill Resort, Virginia, USA with the registration fee exemption.

Official Practice Round – Aug 4th practice flights for international players will be arranged by tournament office. Please contact our international hospitality team for any inquiries regarding practice tee times.

Entry Fee – Entry fee for international player is US\$540 includes:

International Registration Deadline – 6pm(Taipei Time GMT+8) Monday, 8th June, 2025.

The Rules of Golf – The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of golf by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and with the Local Rules provided by the Organizing Committee. Disputes, if any, will be settled by the Organizing Committee, and a decision made by the Organizing Committee will be final.

Dress Regulations – Only acceptable golf attire is permitted. Tank tops, short shorts, swimwear, t-shirts, tank tops and denim are not considered appropriate attire and should not be worn during competition. International team attire is recommended at the official ceremonies.

Pace of Play – Pace of play is strictly reinforced during this tournament, players must keep their playing pace in accordance with the hole-by-hole-timetable of playing pace provided by tournament rule committee to avoid warning and penalty.

Use of trolley and Motorized Carts – A, B divisions play without caddy and motorized carts. Use of pull trolley are allowed. A limited number of trolley are available for rent, please inquire tournament office for booking, first come first serve. Other divisions are played with house caddies and are allowed to ride in motorized carts driven by caddie.

Spectators – Spectators are allowed and MUST obtain a permit at the tournament desk before walking into the course. Failing to comply with the condition and safety rules of spectating will be escorted from the golf course by the tournament marshal.

Use of Measurement Equipment – Measurement device with specifications approved by R&A or USGA are allowed to be used in this event.

Serious Breach of Etiquette – Following actions will be considered as serious breach of etiquette, maximum penalty is disqualification

- (A) Verbal or physical violence at fellow competitors/officials/staff/other guests
- (B) Improper behaviors such as damage other's property or acting dangerously out of emotional issues
- (C) Smoking or consuming alcoholic drinks during a stipulated round

Play Off – In case of a tie, when the conditions allow, the A and B divisions will play the 18th hole in the sudden death format until a winner in each group is determined. Committee reserves the right to make final decision for determination.

Publicity – GPAT arranges publicity before, during and after the tournament. It is a condition of entry that all players assent to references to them and pictures of them in practice and play being published via any medium (including the internet)
